We selected Red Man from Matheny Herefords to complement our Merit-sired females, and he is now getting heavy AI use by very prominent herds across the country. He will be on display sale day. We don't know where to start on featuring the spring pairs—they are loaded with the most notable cow families in the Hereford breed. The opportunities are endless, with many needing to enter a donor program. We are excited for each of you to be able to see what we have to offer.

We are truly blessed to work side by side with our family and loved ones. Living and working with family on our cattle operation is something we don't take for granted, and we are forever grateful to the good Lord above for the blessings of being able to do what we love. 




